JOB DESCRIPTIONS

SATCHMO SALUTE PARADE [SUNDAY MORNING ONLY] 10:30AM-1:00PM

[ST. AUGUSTINE CHURCH]

Parade Volunteers will be at the front of our '**Satchmo Salute' Parade** and must be comfortable holding/carrying banners and walking roughly **15 blocks**. You will meet at **St. Augustine Church**, and are welcome to sit and enjoy the Jazz Mass, which takes place 10:00am - 11:00am. Shortly after, the parade will begin at 11:00am and finish at the festival grounds. Shift location: St. Augustine Church is located at: 1210 Governor Nicholls St, New Orleans, LA 70116.

CHECK-IN TENT

[BARRACKS]

Volunteers will assist the check-in process of fellow volunteers, help locate booths, and provide volunteer t-shirts and RFID cards. Being able to take direction well and adapt under busy environments is a plus. Knowledge of Satchmo SummerFest, New Orleans, and the French Quarter is strongly advised but not a must.

INFORMATION DESK [1st Floor Inside at Front Desk]

[NO JAZZ MUSEUM]

Information assistance volunteers work with the New Orleans Jazz Museum staff to help festival-goers with questions, supply brochures and publications, give directions, and may be asked for suggestions as a local. By making these items available to attendees the Festival shows its support and appreciation of sponsors and supporters encouraging future support. Knowledge of Satchmo SummerFest, New Orleans, and the French Quarter is strongly advised.

BEER BOOTH *21+ Age Requirement

[BARRACKS/ESPLANADE]

Volunteers will be asked to pour drinks and pass them to employed cashiers. They may also be asked to help restock beverage inventory during their shift and may occasionally be asked to lift up to 15 pounds. This job may require standing in a small and sometimes wet area for the duration of the shift. Money handling will not be involved.

PIANO SERIES STAGE [2nd Floor]

[NO JAZZ MUSEUM]

Volunteers will support this unique indoor stage by giving information to attendees, helping with crowd control and seating, and general tidiness of the space between performances. We ask that volunteers remain professional and courteous to attendees and speakers alike.

LEGACY STAGE [3rd Floor]

[NO JAZZ MUSEUM]

The Satchmo Legacy Stage features two days of fascinating discussions and presentations by renowned Armstrong scholars on the 3rd floor of the NO Jazz Museum. Volunteers will assist staff in giving information to attendees, helping with seating, and general tidiness in between speakers. We ask that volunteers remain professional and courteous to attendees and speakers alike.

FESTIVAL SUPPORT KREWE [FLOATER] *21+ Age Requirement

[FESTIVAL-WIDE]

Volunteers may be asked to do any of the volunteer jobs at any of the locations. Support krewe members will serve as floaters who fill in voids from no-shows or unforeseen gaps in scheduling. Volunteers may be asked to serve alcohol, therefore this position requires volunteers who are 21+. This job may require standing for the duration of the shift.

CHILL KREWE

[FESTIVAL-WIDE]

Help us keep festivalgoers cool! Chill Krewe volunteers will be responsible for icing down neck chillers and delivering rolling ice chests to a designated distribution point. The neck chillers are free to the public so they go fast. Once an ice chest is in place for attendees to access, you'll begin prepping the next one to ensure a steady supply. This role is active and requires rolling heavy coolers. Your support keeps the crowd refreshed and comfortable all weekend long!

SURVEY TAKER

[FESTIVAL-WIDE]

This job is one of our highest priorities! Each year French Quarter Festivals, Inc. and The University of New Orleans collaborate on a survey questionnaire. The results from this survey are crucial for our economic impact study and help us to continue presenting our festivals each year. Volunteers are asked to approach attendees and encourage completion of visitor surveys. Each survey consists of approximately 26 questions and takes approximately five minutes to complete. This job is autonomous, requires an outgoing personality, and to be mobile and/or standing for the shift's duration.

GREEN TEAM

[FESTIVAL-WIDE]

Are you passionate about sustainability, our environment, or local recycling? If yes, the Green Team is for you! Satchmo SummerFest is a premier event leading the region in sustainable efforts. Volunteers will be stationed at one of many 'Sorting Stations' that collect compost, recycling, and trash destined for landfill, educating attendees on which receptacle to use. Green Team Volunteers will be spread out throughout the Festival Grounds and may also be asked to assist at the Geauxing Green Info tent. Volunteers will help ensure that there is no contamination between waste streams and that the public is engaged with the system. This dynamic role is a great fit for larger groups!

STAGE TENT USHER

[ESPLANADE/BARRACKS]

The Stage Tent Usher position is an essential Volunteer role at FQFI festivals. Volunteers in this role will be stationed at the *Front Of House* for a single outdoor music stage, and will be standing for the majority of their shift. This position involves keeping specific aisleways, access ramps, and walkways clear at all times of stationary pedestrians and chairs, in order to maintain open paths for the crowd to navigate. Stage ushers are also responsible for keeping attendees from setting up chairs in front of designated chair line. Additionally, the stage usher will assist the security guard in managing the entrance to the Accessible Viewing Area(s).

MERCHANDISE BOOTH

[BARRACKS]

Volunteers will help customers, restock inventory, and keep booths clean and organized. Sales experience is preferred but not required – just be sure to bring lots of smiles and a great attitude! This job requires standing in a small area for the duration of the shift.

DONATION KREWE

[FESTIVAL-WIDE]

FQFI relies on donations to produce this free community festival. This year we will be soliciting donations from attendees at select entry gates. Volunteers will be interacting with attendees as they enter and exit festival areas, encouraging donations and educating about the organization's need and impact. This is a job for outgoing folks who feel passionate about our community! Donation team volunteers will be standing for the duration of the shift.
